This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following administrative rules regulating home for the aged:	
325.1921	Governing bodies, administrators, and supervisors.
	<p>(1) The owner, operator, and governing body of a home shall do all of the following:</p> <p>(b) Assure that the home maintains an organized program to provide room and board, protection, supervision, assistance, and supervised personal care for its residents.</p>
During the onsite, the storage room on the second floor was propped open. The storage room contained Windex cleanser, and an oxygen tank that could be easily accessed by residents. Clean linen was also stored in the same room.	
325.1964	Interiors.
	(11) A doorway, passageway, corridor, hallway, or stairwell shall be kept free from obstructions at all times.
A walker and a wheelchair were found to be stored in the stairwell on the first floor.

	(6) Food and drink used in the home shall be clean and wholesome and shall be manufactured, handled, stored, prepared, transported, and served so as to be safe for human consumption.
Multiple perishable food items in the commercial kitchen's walk-in refrigerator and freezer were observed not to have an open date. These food items included pickle relish, garlic, and ketchup.	

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
