ALLEGATION:

A kitchen drawer needs to be repaired

INVESTIGATION:

On 9/30/25, I interviewed the referral (RS) by phone. The RS reported she conducted a home visit and expressed concerns about the condition of the facility. The RS provided several pictures including a picture of a kitchen drawer that appeared to be off the track.

On 9/30/25, I interviewed home manager Danyelle Dixon at the facility. Ms. Dixon reported the facility currently has four residents but is licensed for six residents. Ms. Dixon acknowledged there are some repairs that need to be made and the licensee is working on making the repairs.

On 9/30/25, I conducted an on-site inspection and noted several areas of concern including a kitchen drawer that did not appear to be closed and after further inspection I noted the track was missing and needed to be repaired or replaced.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14403	Maintenance of premises.
	(2) Home furnishings and housekeeping standards shall present a comfortable, clean, and orderly appearance.
ANALYSIS:	It was alleged one of the kitchen drawers was in need of repair. Based on interviews and observations this violation will be established. During an on-site inspection I noted one of the kitchen drawers was not attached properly and was in need of repair.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

ALLEGATION:

The exterior of the facility needs to be repaired.

INVESTIGATION:

On 9/30/25, I conducted an on-site inspection and noted there was siding that was falling off the home, siding that was not fully attached around two windows, vines growing between the siding and the home and the gutters were full of debris. I also noted there were items near the driveway that needed to be discarded.

APPLICABLE RULE		
R 400.14403	Maintenance of premises.	
	(4) A roof, exterior walls, doors, skylights, and windows shall be weathertight and watertight and shall be kept in sound condition and good repair.	
ANALYSIS:	It was alleged the exterior of the facility needs to be repaired. Based on observations this violation will be established. During an on-site inspection I noted there were areas where the siding was falling off the facility and not properly attached around several windows. I also noted some of the gutters were full of debris and there were vines growing in between the siding and the facility.	
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED	

ALLEGATION:

Interior floors and walls are in need of repair.

INVESTIGATION:

On 9/30/25, I conducted an on-site inspection and noted the floor in the bathroom was sagging, the bathroom walls needed to be painted and repaired, there was missing floor trim in one of the bedrooms and between the dining room and living room.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14403	Maintenance of premises.
	(5) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be finished so as to be easily cleanable and shall be kept clean and in good repair.
ANALYSIS:	It was alleged the interior floors and walls are in need of repair. Based on observations this violation will be established. During an on-site inspection I noted the floor in the resident bathroom was sagging and the walls needed to be repaired and painted. I also noted the trim needed to be replaced in the bathroom, a resident bathroom and between the dining room and living room.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

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On 9/30/25, I shared the findings of my investigation with licensee Victor Holland at the facility. Mr. Holland acknowledged the findings and agreed to submit a corrective action plan.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Based on the submission of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend no change to the current license status.
