This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.14204 Direct care staff; qualifications and training.

(3) A licensee or administrator shall provide in-service training or make training available through other sources to direct care staff. Direct care staff shall be competent before performing assigned tasks, which shall include being competent in all of the following areas:

(b) First aid.

I observed that direct care staff Bert Pemberton First aid card was expired.

R 400.14204 Direct care staff; qualifications and training.

(3) A licensee or administrator shall provide in-service training or make training available through other sources to direct care staff. Direct care staff shall be competent before performing assigned tasks, which shall include being competent in all of the following areas:

(c) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

I observed that direct care staff Bert Pemberton Cardiopulmonary resuscitation card was expired.

R 400.14205 Health of a licensee, direct care staff, administrator, other employees, those volunteers under the direction of the licensee, and members of the household.

(6) A licensee shall annually review the health status of the administrator, direct care staff, other employees, and members of the household. Verification of annual reviews shall be maintained by the home and shall be available for department review.

Direct care staff Bert Pemberton did not have an annual health review completed in 2024.

R 400.14313 Resident nutrition.

(6) Records of menus, including special diets, shall be kept by the licensee for 1 calendar year.

I did not observe menus for 2024.

R 400.14316 Resident records.

(1) A licensee shall complete, and maintain in the home, a separate record for each resident and shall provide record information as required by the department. A resident record shall include, at a minimum, all of the following information:

(d) Health care information, including all of the following:

(i) Health care appraisals

Resident B did not have a *Health Care Appraisal* completed in 2023 or 2024.

R 400.14316 Resident records.

(1) A licensee shall complete, and maintain in the home, a separate record for each resident and shall provide record information as required by the department. A resident record shall include, at a minimum, all of the following information:

(e) Resident care agreement.

Resident B did not have a *Resident Care Agreement* completed in 2023.

R 400.14316 Resident records.

(1) A licensee shall complete, and maintain in the home, a separate record for each resident and shall provide record information as required by the department. A resident record shall include, at a minimum, all of the following information:

(f) Assessment plan.

Resident B did not have an *Assessment Plan* completed in 2023 or 2024.

R 400.14203 Licensee and administrator training requirements.

(1) A licensee and an administrator shall complete the following educational requirements specified in subdivision (a) or (b) of this subrule, or a combination thereof, on an annual basis:

(a) Participate in, and successfully complete, 16 hours of training designated or approved by the department that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement.

The licensee/administrator, Kimberley Pemberton did not have 16 hours of training relevant to the admission policy or program statement completed in 2023.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
