**ALLEGATION: The son of the Licensee is on parole and has been living in the home but was recently arrested due to domestic violence.**

**INVESTIGATION:** On December 4, 2025, I conducted an unannounced on-site special investigation at the Hidden Acres AFC home. I met with Licensee Christine Nash and informed her of the above stated allegations. Ms. Nash acknowledged that her son, Jack Schonebeck, is on parole and had been residing on the property in a living unit located in a barn on the same property as the AFC home. It is noted that the barn is approximately 40-50 yards from the AFC home. She stated that he is currently in jail after recently being arrested for domestic violence. Ms. Nash stated she did not think she needed to inform me that her son, who is on parole and was living in the barn, because it is not inside of the AFC structure. She noted that her son will be in jail “for a year or more” and that he will not be living on the property of the AFC home once he is released.

<b>R 400.623</b>	<b>Applicant, licensee and administrator qualifications; licensee, administrator and staff requirements; parole or probation or convicted of felony.</b>
	<b>(9) The licensee shall notify the department of the name of any volunteer or member of the household who is on a court-supervised probation or parole or has been convicted</b>

	<b>of a felony. Notification must be within 48 hours of the licensee becoming aware.</b>
<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	Licensee Christine Nash failed to inform the department that her son, who is on parole, had been residing on the property of the AFC home.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION ESTABLISHED</b>

**ALLEGATION: There is a hole in the floor of a resident bedroom.**

**INVESTIGATION:** Ms. Nash acknowledged that a small hole in the floor of Resident A's bedroom has developed. She explained that Resident A's bedpost had worn, or "punched", a small hole through the flooring. She noted that this hole "has not been there very long" and that she is communicating with her landlord to have it fixed.

Ms. Nash and I entered Resident A's bedroom. I observed a hole in the flooring, and subfloor, that was approximately two inches in diameter.

<b>R 400.647</b>	<b>Safety and maintenance of premises.</b>
	<b>(5) Floors, walls, and ceilings must be cleanable, maintained clean, and in good repair.</b>
<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	The Licensee is not maintaining Resident A's bedroom floor in good repair.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION ESTABLISHED</b>

On December 4, 2025, I conducted an exit conference with Licensee Christine Nash. I explained my findings as noted above. Ms. Nash stated she understood the findings, had no additional information to provide, nor questions to ask, concerning this special investigation. She stated she would submit a corrective action plan to address these cites rules and begin repairs to Resident A's flooring right away.
