ALLEGATION: Resident A fell down after she was pushed by staff Mosi Jones.

INVESTIGATION:

On 11/17/2025, APS and ORR referrals were made/received. The APS referral stated that on 11/11/2025 when Resident A was having a behavioral outburst and assaulting direct care staff Mosi Jones, he responded by assaulting her which resulted in her falling down.

On 11/20/2025, I interviewed Resident A. She had no consistent recollection of being assaulted by direct care staff Mosi Jones. She did not have any bruises and/or abrasions from falling down.

On 11/20/2025, I interviewed Daniel Bogosian, licensee designee. He provided the names and telephone numbers of the direct care staff on duty or involved in the incident as well as incident reports. I reviewed the incident reports dated 11/11/2025. The three incident reports all describe Resident A engage in throwing chairs and assaulting or attempting to assault other residents and staff. One of the incident reports details that direct care staff Mosi Jones admitted to assaulting Resident A by pushing her when she was attempting to assault him. The incident report details that Mosi Jones admitted to not using the approved behavioral intervention he was trained to use and he was sent home for the remainder of the shift. Daniel Bogosian stated that as a result of Eisenhower Center's internal investigation, direct care staff Mosi Jones had already been suspended for 5 days, retrained and will be assigned to a different Eisenhower Center facility.

On 11/20/2025, I telephone interviewed direct care staffs (a) Mareace Rutley; (b) LaNia Slaton; (c) Lawanda Bennett; (d) Tracey Ward; (e) Mosi Jones.

Direct care staff Maureace Rutley did not return my calls. Lawanda Bennett and Tracey Ward stated that they did not witness the incident, but Lawanda Bennett stated that Mosi Jones admitted to her that he pushed Resident A. LaNia Slaton stated that she witnessed Mosi Jones assault Resident A, that he did not follow the behavioral protocol, and that he could have walked away. Finally, Mosi Jones stated that he followed the behavioral protocol, but when I questioned his answer, he refused to answer any other questions.

On 11/21/2025, I telephoned Guardian A1. She stated that she was aware of the incident and was satisfied with Resident A's placement.

On 11/21/2025, I conducted an exit conference with Daniel Bogosian.

On 11/25/2025, An acceptable corrective action plan was received and approved.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.641	Resident behavior interventions.
	(5) Staff, volunteers, visitors, or other occupants of the facility shall not mistreat a resident. Mistreatment includes any intentional action or omission that exposes a resident to serious risk, physical or emotional harm, or the deliberate infliction of pain by any means.

ANALYSIS:	The preponderance of credible evidence is that staff Mosi Jones admitted to not following Resident A's behavioral protocol, and by assaulting her, he mistreated Resident A as defined above.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Since an acceptable plan of correction was received, I recommend no change in the license status.
