IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 08/13/2025, licensee designee Shakiyla Bradford submitted training documentation, a new admission policy and program statement.

Comfort Care Assisted Living provides compassionate residential care and support for individuals who are elderly, living with Alzheimer's disease or related conditions, living with mental illness, or living with developmental disabilities.

(a) Philosophy and Mission

- Elderly Care: Comfort Care Assisted Living is committed to supporting seniors with dignity, independence, and respect while promoting safety, social connection, and overall wellness.

- Alzheimer's/Dementia Care: Comfort Care Assisted Living's mission is to provide a safe, supportive environment that recognizes each individual's history, abilities, and needs, with specialized care that promotes comfort and quality of life.

- Mental Illness Care: Comfort Care Assisted Living believes in recovery-oriented, person-centered care that emphasizes respect, stabilization, and helping residents develop coping skills in a safe and structured environment.

- Developmental Disability Care: Comfort Care Assisted Living provides individualized supports that promote independence, skill-building, and community involvement while ensuring safety and dignity.

(b) Placement, Transfer, and Discharge

- Placement: Admission is based on an assessment of individual needs, program suitability, and available accommodations.

- Transfer/Discharge: Residents may be transferred or discharged if their care needs exceed what can be safely provided, if their condition significantly changes, or if continued placement poses a risk. In all cases, families and care teams are included in decisions, and safe transition planning is provided.

(c) Assessment and Care Planning

All residents receive a comprehensive assessment upon admission. Based on the assessment, an individualized care plan is created to address:

- Medical and mental health needs
 - Daily living support
 - Activity and social engagement
 - Safety concerns
- Care plans are reviewed regularly and updated as needs change.

(d) Staff Training and Continuing Education

Comfort Care Assisted Living staff receive specialized training in:

- Elderly Care: Aging, fall prevention, chronic illness management, nutrition.
- Alzheimer's/Dementia Care: Memory care, communication strategies, behavior management.
- Mental Illness Care: Crisis intervention, de-escalation, medication support, trauma-informed care.
- Developmental Disability Care: Skill-building, communication supports, behavioral interventions, independence promotion.

Ongoing continuing education ensures best practices across all populations.

(e) Physical Environment and Design Features

- Safe, secure, and accessible living spaces.
- Features such as non-slip flooring, grab bars, secured outdoor areas, and visual cues.
- Homelike design that reduces stress and promotes independence.
- Monitoring and safety systems tailored to residents' unique needs.

(f) Activities for Residents

Comfort Care Assisted Living offers activities tailored to each population:

- Elderly: Social gatherings, exercise programs, wellness activities.
- Alzheimer's/Dementia: Music therapy, reminiscence activities, calming sensory activities.
- Mental Illness: Support groups, structured routines, recreational and wellness activities.
- Developmental Disabilities: Skill development, community participation, creative and sensory activities.

Activities are individualized and adapted to promote engagement and quality of life.

Comfort Care Assisted Living is committed to providing high-quality, compassionate care for elderly adults, individuals with Alzheimer's or dementia, those living with mental illness, and individuals with developmental disabilities. Comfort Care Assisted Living will partner with families to ensure residents live with dignity, respect, and comfort.

I recommend the Aged and Alzheimer's population be added to the license.


