**II. METHODOLOGY**

**ALLEGATION:**

Resident A is not receiving help with his ADL's and is not being cleaned up during each shift.

**INVESTIGATION:**

On 08/08/2025, a complaint was received from Adult Protective Services (APS) that was not assigned, alleging that Resident A was not receiving help with ADL's and was not being cleaned up during each shift.

On 08/21/2025, an onsite investigation was conducted in which I interviewed Brandy Aucunas, Executive Director, who reported that the subject of the complaint (Resident A) no longer resides at the facility as the resident was on hospice and had passed away recently. The Executive Director reported that there have been no complaints of residents not receiving personal care or help with their ADL's. The Executive Director also reported that the facility had recently been through a similar special investigation last week and remarked about the possibility that a disgruntled former employee may have made the complaint to APS.

On 08/21/2025, I toured the facility with the Executive Director and observed the residents there were clean, well dressed and look cared for. The Executive Director reported that there are many activities residents are encouraged to participate in such as crafts and exercise sessions, et.al.

On 8/21/2025 I interviewed Resident B in his room. Resident B reported that he receives good care, does not have to wait long for his call light to be answered and

overall is satisfied with the services he receives. His room appeared tidy and organized.

On 8/21/2025, I interviewed Resident C sitting in the dining area, who had no complaints about the care he receives at the facility. He was clean and dressed appropriately.

On 08/21/2025, I interviewed Resident D who was sitting in the common area and watching television. She was well dressed, conversational, and had no complaints about the care she receives from the facility.

<b>APPLICABLE RULE</b>	
<b>R 325.1933</b>	<b>Personal care of residents.</b>
	<b>(1) A home shall provide a resident with necessary assistance with personal care such as, but not limited to, care of the skin, mouth and teeth, hands and feet, and the shampooing and grooming of the hair as specified in the resident's service plan.</b> <b>(2) A home shall afford a resident the opportunity and instructions when necessary for daily bathing, oral and personal hygiene, daily shaving, and hand washing before meals. A home shall ensure that a resident bathes at least weekly and more often if necessary.</b>
<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	Interview and observation revealed no evidence that residents were not receiving daily help with their ADL's or not being cleaned up appropriately. There is no evidence that the facility is not compliant with this rule.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION NOT ESTABLISHED</b>

### III. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend no change in the status of the license.
