ALLEGATION:

On 12/12/2025, direct care staff Alvin Smith aggressively restrained Resident A during an elopement attempt.

INVESTIGATION:

On 1/13/2026, I made an APS.

On 1/13/2026, Resident A was observed but not interviewed because he is non-verbal.

On 1/13/2026, I interviewed Daniel Bogosian, licensee designee. He stated that

direct care staff Alvin Smith’s employment was terminated on 1/3/2026 after an internal investigation. We reviewed a copy of the incident report filed by direct care staff Mariah Fletcher.

On 1/13/2026, I interviewed direct care staff, Mariah Fletcher. She stated that on 12/12/2025, when she was leaving work, she witnessed Resident A attempting to elope with Alvin Smith grabbing his arm to prevent his elopement, and as they engaged in a physical altercation with Resident A falling to the ground and hitting his head, Alvin Smith lifted Resident A by the collar of his coat and his arms dragging him back into the facility. Finally, she stated that as she was consoling Resident A, who was crying on the ground, she overheard Alvin Smith say, “I can’t deal with this on a Friday.”

On 1/13/2026, I telephoned direct care staff, Alvin Smith. His telephone was disconnected.

On 1/13/2026, I telephoned Guardian A1. He stated that he knew about the incident and was looking for a new placement for Resident A.

On 1/13/2026, I conducted an exit conference with Daniel Bogosian. He stated that he agreed with the findings of Alvin Smith mistreating Resident A.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.641	Resident behavior interventions.
	(5) Staff, volunteers, visitors, or other occupants of the facility shall not mistreat a resident. Mistreatment includes any intentional action or omission that exposes a resident to serious risk, physical or emotional harm, or the deliberate infliction of pain by any means.
ANALYSIS:	Since staff Mariah Fletcher witnessed Alvin Smith’s altercation with Resident A, Alvin Smith provided no rebuttal and the licensee terminated Alvin Smith’s employment, then direct care staff, Alvin Smith, mistreated Resident A with his intentional act that exposed Resident A to serious risk of physical harm.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan,
I recommend no change in the license status.
