II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to license an additional resident bedroom for two residents to share and increase resident capacity from 4 to 6. Licensee Natalie Hendricks has requested that the facility's space be modified from two resident bedrooms to three resident bedrooms and increase the capacity from 4 to 6 residents.

III. Methodology

On 03/19/2026, while onsite Ms. Hendricks submitted a request to license an additional resident bedroom and increase capacity to 6 residents. I observed the original licensing report indicates the facility was licensed to accommodate 4 residents in two shared resident bedrooms located on the main floor. I observed that the total square footage of the home includes 306 square feet of living space which is adequate for six residents. While onsite I measured the purposed third resident bedroom located on the main floor of the facility measured 9.58 x 13.58, for a total of 130 square feet. I observed that the bedroom contains permanently constructed closets and an easily openable window for safe egress.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility is a residential building licensed to accommodate six residents. I have reviewed the facility's floor plans, original licensing study report, and licensee written request to modify the building's space. I have observed that the facility's space satisfies licensing rules to increase the number of resident bedrooms from two to three and increase the resident capacity from 4 to 6.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the building's space be modified to accommodate six residents in three shared bedrooms.
