III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.645 Environmental health.

(3) A licensee shall provide hot and cold running water under pressure. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the fixture.

At the time of inspection, the hot water throughout the home did not range between 105 to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the fixture.

- Main bathroom, 136.6 degrees Fahrenheit
- Bathroom in resident bedroom, 137.1 degrees Fahrenheit
- Kitchen, 140.2 degrees Fahrenheit

***CORRECTED ONSITE.**

R 400.675 Resident medications.

(4) A licensee, administrator, or direct care staff shall comply with the following when supervising the taking of medication by a resident:

(b) Complete an individual medication log that contains all of the following:

- (i) Medication name.
- (ii) Dosage.
- (iii) Label instructions for use.
- (iv) Time to be administered.
- (v) Initials of the individual who administered the medication at the time given.
- (vi) Resident's refusal to accept prescribed medication or procedures at time of refusal.

At the time of inspection, Resident B's medication administration records (MARs) were not initialed at the time the medication was given. The MARs were initialed on 02/29/2026 for all 8am medications; 2026 is not a leap year and there were only 28 days in February.

The medications were as follows:

Docusate Sodium 100mg PO CAP, take one capsule by mouth twice every day was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Furosemide 20mg PO Tab, take 1 tablet by mouth once daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Ezetimibe 10mg PO Tab, take 1 tablet by mouth once daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Aspirin Low Dose 81mg EC TAB, take 1 tablet by mouth once daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Potassium Chloride ER 20MEQ SA TAB, take 1 tablet by mouth every day was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Fenofibrate 48mg PO TAB, take 1 tablet by mouth once daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Loratadine 10mg PO TAB, take 1 tablet by mouth once daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Propranolol Hydrochloride 10mg PO Tab, take ½ tablet by mouth every morning was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Senna 8.6mg PO TAB, take 1 tablet by mouth twice daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Chlorhexidine Gluconate 0.12% PO SOL, rinse with ½ ounce twice daily after breakfast and at bedtime after brushing and flossing as directed was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Hydrocortisone 1% to Cream, apply topically to affected area(s) externally twice daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Polyethylene Glycol 3350 17gm PO Each, mix 17 grams (1 packet) in 8oz of water and drink once daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Fluoxetine Hydrochloride 40mg PO CAP, take 1 capsule by mouth once daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

carbamazepine 100mg CH TAB, chew and swallow by mouth one tablet twice daily was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

Fish Oil1000mg PO CAP, take one capsule by mouth twice every day was initialed on 02/29/2026 at 8am.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
