### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

**R 400.647                      Safety and maintenance of premises.**

**(15) Sidewalks, fire escape routes, and entrances must be kept reasonably free of hazards, such as ice, snow, and debris.**

- The gutters were not draining properly, causing water to leak on to the cement by the entrance of the facility, creating a hazard.

**R 400.647                      Safety and maintenance of premises.**

**(5) Floors, walls, and ceilings must be cleanable, maintained clean, and in good repair.**

- There was a brown residue on the ceiling in the dining area of the facility.
- There was a black residue on the ceilings in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> bathrooms.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license and the special certification are recommended.
