III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:	
R 325.1953	Menus.
	(1) A home shall prepare and post the menu for regular and therapeutic or special diets for the current week. Changes shall be written on the planned menu to show the menu as actually served.
There was not a menu posted for regular, therapeutic or special diet for the current week.	
R 325.1970	Water supply systems.
	(7) The temperature of hot water at plumbing fixtures used by residents shall be regulated to provide tempered water at a range of 105 to 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
The water temperature in several residents' rooms was not regulated to provide tempered water at the range of to 120 degrees Fahrenheit. For example, in room 125 the water temperature was 128.7 and in room SC5, the water temperature was 125.1.	
R 325.1976	Kitchen and dietary.
	(5) The kitchen and dietary area, as well as all food being stored, prepared, served, or transported, shall be protected against potential contamination from dust, flies, insects, vermin, overhead sewer lines, and other sources.
Multiple items observed in walk in refrigerator and dry storage opened, repackaged, and not dated such as but not limited to meat products, mayonnaise, salad dressing, ketchup, bread, etc.	

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
