II. Purpose of Addendum

Licensee Designee, Georgina Adatsi has made a verbal request to modify the terms of the current license to include wheelchair accessibility.

III. Methodology

An AFC licensing renewal inspection was completed at the facility on 05/27/26. During this inspection I observed this facility with two means of egress which can accommodate residents who require the use of a wheelchair. The front exit has a newly constructed wheelchair accessible ramp that leads to the paved driveway. On file is building approval from the City of Portage for this wheelchair ramp. A secondary exit from a dining room hallway leads to a wheelchair accessible ramp that leads to the paved driveway through a garage door. The facility has doorways that measure at least 32 inches wide for these two exits as well as resident bedrooms and bathrooms.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

After completion of the on-site renewal inspection, it can be determined that the facility meets the requirements for wheelchair accessibility by having adequate means of egress, sufficient accommodation for personal hygiene, and doorways that are wide enough to accommodate a wheelchair

V. Recommendation

I recommend the license be updated to add wheelchair accessibility.
