III. METHODOLOGY

ALLEGATION:

On 5/19/2026, Staff Jeffrey Bryant allegedly threatened to choke Resident A.

INVESTIGATION:

On 5/21/2026, a phone conversation took place with ORR (Office of Recipient Rights) investigator, Lindsay Hebel, who confirmed that she was investigating the same allegations and she had already spoken to Resident A. ORR Hebel stated that Resident A confirmed that staff person, Jeffrey Bryant made a statement threatening to choke him. ORR Hebel stated that Resident A told her that staff person, Heather Crowley, witnessed the incident.

On 5/22/2026, an on-site inspection was conducted and Resident A was interviewed. Resident A appeared uncomfortable talking about these allegations but stated that he does remember Staff Bryant threatening to choke him. Resident A stated that he does not remember what Staff Bryant exactly said to Resident A, but that Resident A does remember it had something to do with choking and that Resident A felt threatened by him. Resident A reported that he has not had any problems with Staff Bryant since that incident.

On 5/22/2026, home manager, Ronia Garner, stated that Resident A did not want to talk to her about these allegations, due to being afraid of retaliation from Staff Bryant. HM Garner stated that Resident A has told her that Staff Bryant has raised his voice at him on a few occasions and that he is afraid of Staff Bryant. HM Garner reported that Resident A is usually pretty honest about things.

On 5/22/2026, Resident B stated that Staff Bryant has cussed at residents, has made threats to him and can be very intimidating. When asked to provide examples of threats Staff Bryant has made toward him, Resident B said that Staff Bryant told him, "If you talk to me when I tell you not to talk to me, there is going to be a problem". Resident B reported that on 5/15/2026, Staff Bryant said to him, "I really want to punch you in the face". Resident B stated that he is not sure if anyone else heard Staff Bryant say those things. Resident B reported that Staff Bryant has been disrespectful toward him regarding him being a cross dresser and told him, "When I work, you are going to be a man". Resident B stated that Staff Bryant said that to him in private.

On 5/22/2026, Resident C stated that Staff Bryant has tried to intimidate him by raising his voice at him, but that he just ignores him when he does that. Resident C did not want to provide any further details regarding Staff Bryant, but he did confirm that Staff Bryant cusses at residents.

On 5/22/2026, Resident D stated that Staff Bryant will be stern and get loud with other residents, but not with him. Resident D stated that he has heard Staff Bryant cuss at other residents, but that Staff Bryant has not cussed at or disrespected him. Resident D did not want to provide any further detailed information.

On 5/29/2026, a phone call was made to staff person, Heather Crawley, who confirmed that she worked with Staff Bryant on 5/19/2026. Staff Crawley stated that she heard two people yelling at each other but could not hear details of what was said. Staff Crawley reported that when she got closer to the incident, Resident A was visibly very upset and told her that Staff Bryant had just threatened to choke him. Staff Crawley stated that she is not aware of any of the allegations regarding Staff Bryant and Resident B. Staff Crawley stated that Staff Bryant can be intimidating and get loud with some of the residents, but that she cannot remember hearing him be disrespectful.

On 6/4/2026, a phone call was made to staff person, Naveah Murphy, who confirmed that she has worked with Staff Bryant often. When asked about these allegations, Staff Murphy simply said that she has never witnessed Staff Bryant disrespect any resident.

On 6/4/2026, a phone call was made to staff person, Jeffrey Bryant, who denied all the allegations. Staff Bryant denied that he has ever threatened to choke Resident A. Staff Bryant reported that he has often had conversations with Resident A about his finances. On 5/19/2026, he told Resident A that he no longer wanted to talk to Resident A about his finances because he does not follow his advice and that Resident A got upset with him about that. Staff Bryant denied that he has ever threatened Resident B or said that he wanted to punch Resident B in the face. When asked about Resident B's cross dressing, Staff Bryant stated that he has never said anything negative to Resident B about that issue. Staff Bryant claimed that he told Resident B that people in the community might make fun of him about that and that he would not be able to protect him. Staff Bryant said that he has never intentionally intimidated or disrespected any of the residents.

On 6/11/2026, ORR Hebel reported that she had spoken to Resident A again and that Resident A claimed that he witnessed Staff Bryant tell Resident B, "I want to punch you in the face". ORR Hebel stated that she will be substantiating that abuse took place, in the form of threats.

On 6/11/2026, an exit conference was held with licensee designee, Laura Hatfield-Smith. LD Hatfield-Smith stated that Staff Bryant was suspended right away and that she plans to terminate his employment. LD Hatfield-Smith was informed of the outcome of this investigation and that a corrective action plan is required.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.641	Resident behavior interventions.
	(6) A licensee, staff, volunteers, or any person who lives in the facility shall not do any of the following: (f) Subject a resident to any of the following: (i) Mental or emotional cruelty. (ii) Verbal abuse. (iii) Derogatory remarks. (iv) Threats.

ANALYSIS:	Resident A and Resident B have both stated that staff person, Jeffrey Bryant, has made threats toward them. Resident A told ORR that he witnessed Staff Bryant tell Resident B that he wanted to punch him in the face. Resident C and Resident D stated that Staff Bryant can be loud and intimidating and has cussed at residents. Staff person, Heather Crawley, stated that she heard Staff Bryant yelling at Resident A on 5/19/2026. There was sufficient evidence found to substantiate violation of this licensing rule.
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an approved written corrective action plan, it is recommended that the status of this home's license remains unchanged.
