 - A written policy that medical clearances will be completed within thirty days of the start date for all newly hired employees.
 - A picture showing the kitchen water temperature is not over 120°.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.631	Health screenings.
	(2) A licensee shall have on file a statement signed by a licensed physician or physician's designee attesting to the physical health of the licensee, staff, and members of the household. Statements for the licensee and administrator must be signed no more than 6 months before the issuance of a temporary license and at any other time requested by the department. Statements for staff and members of the household must be obtained within 30 days of employment start date, assumption of duties, or occupancy in the facility.
Direct care staff members N. Babosh, E. Richards, and A. Rea did not have medical clearance completed within 30 days of their employment start date.	
R 400.645	Environmental health.
	(3) A licensee shall provide hot and cold running water under pressure. A licensee shall maintain the hot water temperature for a resident's use at a range of 105 degrees Fahrenheit to 120 degrees Fahrenheit at the fixture.
The kitchen sink temperature was too high at 135 degrees.	
R 400.691	Resident records.
	(1) A licensee shall complete and maintain a separate record for each resident that includes all of the following: (g) Admission and monthly weight record.
Resident A was missing a weight record for 7/2026. Resident B was missing a weight record for 03/2026 and 07/2026. Resident C did not have any weights recorded since 9/2024 because licensee designee Mr. Parker states Resident C refuses to be weighed. REPEAT VIOLATION: RULE 400.14310 (3) was cited on 08/20/2024 renewal because there was only one weight recorded for Resident C. A Corrective Action Plan was submitted on 08/20/2024 stating weights would be recorded for all residents.	

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 08/14/2026. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as

outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

An acceptable corrective action plan has been received. Renewal of the license is recommended.
