II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee requested that the capacity for the home be increased from the existing three, to four beds.

III. Methodology

An on-site inspection of the facility took place on 10-13-04. This inspection included measurements being taken of each of the three bedrooms. These measurements were taken with the assistance of the manager of the program.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

It was determined through this inspection that this facility does not have adequate floor space to accommodate more than one resident per bedroom. All three bedrooms were measured and were found to provide 117 square feet (bedroom #1), 96 square feet (bedroom #2) and 96 square feet (bedroom #3). All three of these bedrooms therefore fall significantly short of the minimum square footage required in R400.14409(3) which specifies that a multi-occupancy resident bedroom shall have not less than 65 square feet of usable floor space per bed.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that the licensee's request for an increase in capacity be denied.
