II. Purpose of Addendum

On 11/29/2005 the licensees filed an application to increase the capacity of their facility from 2 to 3 AFC residents. The licensees hold special certification status.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

In order to increase capacity the licensees propose to have one of their own children move out of his main-floor bedroom. This child will then share an upstairs bedroom with his sister. This will free up the main-floor bedroom for use by an AFC resident.

The new AFC resident bedroom has measurements of 11'4" x 8'5". This translates into 95.39 square feet, more than enough room for one AFC resident.

There are two sources of living space. The living room is 16'5" x 11'5". This translates to 187.51 square feet. The home does not have a separate dining area but has a large kitchen in its place. The amount extra space in the kitchen, which could be considered a dining or recreation area, measures 13'1" x 7'2". This translates into 93.78 square feet. That living room and dining /recreation area added together equals 281.29 square feet. When divided by 8 (5 family members and 3 residents) that equals 35.16 square feet per occupant. This is more than enough living space for 8 occupants.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended this family home license be increased from 2 to 3 AFC residents.
