II. Purpose of Addendum

This addendum will reflect a change in address location for this license due to Eminent Domain proceedings associated with the Hillsdale County Airport. The previous licensee address of 1391 N. Lake Pleasant Road in Hillsdale was located in the path of runway expansion and therefore, the facility needed to move to its current address. The Corporation has been licensed since 9/19/2002 with Karen Stump as the licensee designee and administrator. The licensee has been in substantial compliance with all requirements since being licensed.

III. Methodology

I conducted a facility inspection and found the new facility to exceed all requirements.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility is located on 3.3 acres of land, just down the road from the previous facility address. There is a paved driveway and parking lot, the facility is wheelchair accessible throughout. There are 20 individual bedrooms; each bedroom has their own bathroom consisting of a toilet and sink. There are 3 full sized, handicapped accessible bathrooms for resident use. Kitchen, dining, and resident activity areas exceed the minimum requirements. There is a large basement containing all electrical and fire suppression systems. The Office of Fire Safety has given approval for occupancy. The Hillsdale County Public Health Department has given full approval.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the transfer of the license to the new location.
