To add a bedroom and increase the total licensed capacity.

III. Methodology

On 09/03/2009, licensee Geneva Moore submitted a written request to increase her total licensed capacity to accommodate 5 residents instead of 4.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

During onsite inspection bedroom furnishings and maintenance of premises met rule full compliance. The bedroom was measured and has the following dimensions and capacity.

V. Recommendation

Based on the bedroom, bedroom furnishings, maintenance of premises and measurement, I recommend increasing total licensed capacity from 4 to 5 residents.
