II. Purpose of Addendum

Mrs. Snyder submitted a written request to increase the licensed bed capacity from five beds to six beds.

III. Methodology

A household member passed away in May of 2010, and there are currently 11 household members residing in the home. An on-site inspection was completed on July 16, 2010. Mrs. Snyder submitted floor plans, the rooms were measured, and it was determined that there is adequate space on the second floor to increase the licensed bed capacity to six.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The bedroom for the sixth bed will be located on the second floor. The rooms have been measured and there is adequate spacing for an additional resident.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the licensed bed capacity be increased from five beds to six beds.
