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II. Purpose of Addendum

Increase license capacity from three to five.

III. Methodology

11/15/2010- Inspection completed on-site 11/16/2010- Receipt of occupancy permit from City of Kalamazoo

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

An original temporary license was issued on October 6, 2009 with a capacity of three. The license was renewed to a regular license, again with a capacity of three, on May 7, 2010. The administrator submitted a request for modification to increase the capacity to five, and I conducted an on-site inspection on November 15.

An attached garage has been converted into a bedroom with a square footage capacity of two. The room contains two individual closets; residents will share a dresser. A hallway has been added from the living area to the new bedroom, and an office/medication room has been created in the new space.

The smoke detection system has been expanded to the new area, and a sprinkler system installed as well. Added door hardware is non-locking against egress.

In addition the bathroom has been remodeled to be handicap accessible with a shower.

There remains sufficient living area space to accommodate five home occupants.

With remodeling the facility is now wheelchair accessible. A side walk has been added to the front door which is at ground level. A ramp has been added to a back exit which terminates on a solid surface.

The building inspector for the city of Kalamazoo issued a certificate of occupancy dated November 16, 2010.

Recommendation V.

I recommend that the license capacity be increased from three to five.
