III. Methodology


On 01/31/2011, I completed an on-site inspection.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

I measured bedroom #19 and found that it measured 149 square feet which is ample for two residents. The bedroom also had the required furnishings for two residents as well. The administrator is aware that the capacity for the license remains at 20 residents no matter if the bedrooms are arranged for one or two residents.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that bedroom #19 be changed from being a single occupancy bedroom to a double occupancy bedroom.
