II. Purpose of Addendum

On 09/22/2011 the co-licensees filed an application to increase the capacity of their facility. The facility holds special certification status. The 09/22/2011 written application requested a capacity increase to 4 AFC residents. On 10/06/2011 the co-licensee, Lydia Hodges, verbally requested the capacity be increased to 5 AFC residents.

III. Methodology

On 10/06/2011, I Inspected the facility and interviewed the co-licensee, Lydia Hodges.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

An adult child of the co-licensees has moved out of the house, freeing up an additional main floor bedroom for AFC resident use.


The newly proposed AFC resident bedroom is 15' x 11'10". That equals 177.45 square feet, which is sufficient room to accommodate two AFC residents and complies with Rule 400.1432(2).

The facility has three sources of living space. The living room is 16'5" x 11'5". This equals 187.51 square feet. The home does not have a separate dining area but has a large kitchen in its place. The amount of extra space in the kitchen, which could be considered a dining area, measures 13'1" x 7'2". This equals 93.78 square feet. What used to be a mud room off the kitchen has been converted to a reading room. That room is 8'8" x 8'1", which equals 64.64 square feet. A total of 345.63 square feet of living space is available. When divided by 9 (4 family members and 5 residents) that equals 38.40 square feet per occupant. This affords sufficient space for 9 occupants and complies with Rule 400.1427(1).

This special certification facility already has a hardwired smoke detection system.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the capacity of this facility be increased from 3 to 5 AFC residents.
