II. Purpose of Addendum

To add "wheelchair accessible" to this facility's license.

III. Methodology

On 4/12/2012 I made an onsite inspection.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

This home appears to have been originally constructed to be wheelchair accessible. The front exterior door is 36 inches wide and opens to ground level pavement. The Pavement is smooth and in excellent condition and extends out from the front door about 18 feet where it then meets the driveway, which is also paved and in very good condition. The side door, which is the second means of egress, is also 36 inches wide. It opens to a cement ramp that terminates onto solid, cemented ground, and is in excellent condition. The railing and ramp width and slope are in compliance with licensing rules. Exiting either the front or the side door, wheelchairs residents can easily get a safe distance from the home. The home has 3 bedrooms, all of which have doors that are 36 inches wide. The home also has a walk-in shower stall and a shower chair, making it accessible to wheelchair dependent residents. There are no bearers throughout the home; a person in a wheelchair can go in every area of the home, except the basement, which is not used by residents anyway.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that "wheelchair accessible" be added to this facility's license.
