II. Purpose of Addendum

Licensee requested in writing an increase in capacity and requested the computer room be converted to a bedroom. The bedroom has two beds and dressers in it and was measured at the original licensing study report (as a computer room). The licensee amended the fire evacuation plan for that room.

III. Methodology

05/04/2012 Contact-Document Received I received a written letter requesting an increase of capacity from three residents to four residents by the licensee.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

During my on-site inspection on April 25, 2012, it was noted the computer room was converted to a second bedroom for two residents. The bedroom contained two dressers and two twin beds. The room measured 13'4" x 10' equaling 133.30 square feet, adequate for two residents and meeting compliance with Rule 400.1432 (2) which is 65 square feet per bed. In addition, the living space in the home totals 240.71 in the living room/dining room and 56.84 square feet in the kitchenette totaling 297.55 square feet. Total occupants in the home are five, and the requirement is 35 square feet per person (Rule 400.1427 (1) of living space or 175 square feet minimum needed) so the facility is in compliance with living space.

The licensee is able to be licensed for up to four (4) residents.

V. Recommendation

The licensee's written request for an increase in capacity from three to four residents is approved.
