II. Purpose of Addendum

Telephone request from Ms. Linda Allen on June 29, 2012, to increase capacity of her license from four residents to six residents. Written request received on July 10, 2012.

III. Methodology

June 29, 2012 contact – Telephone call from Ms. Linda Allen requesting to increase the capacity of her license from four residents to six. Written request submitted on July 10, 2012. On July 12, 2012 conducted on-site inspection. Also, follow-up on-site inspection conducted on July 13, 2012.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On-site inspection conducted on July 12, 2012, to measure bedroom. The bedroom measured 15ft by 18ft (270 square feet). The beds were three feet apart. The room was furnished with two dressers, two night stands, two twin size beds, two chairs and one mirror. The room has a large walk-in closet and two large working screened windows. The beds were completely furnished with pillows, comforters, sheets, blankets and mattress protectors. The adjoining bathroom had one window, exhaust fan, sink, toilet, bathtub equipped with handrails attached to the shower/tub, and non-skid surface in the bathtub. Both the bedroom door and bathroom door have latching, non-locking egress door hardware.

The bathroom water temperature was tested and was 128 degrees Fahrenheit. I informed Ms. Allen that the water temperature must be between 105 – 120 degrees Fahrenheit. She stated that she would have the water adjusted and will set up another appointment to test the water temperature.

Received a call from Ms. Allen on July 12, 2012, in the late afternoon stating she had adjusted the bathroom water temperature. On-site inspection conducted on July 13, 2012, at 9:00am to test the water temperature. The bathroom water temperature was 109 degrees Fahrenheit.

The bedroom is appropriate for the occupancy of two residents.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the capacity of the license be increased from four residents to six residents.
