II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of the addendum is to include the Alzheimer's/Dementia care program to the Charlotte Stephenson Manor temporary license and to increase the capacity from 50 beds to 60 beds, as the 10-bed Alzheimer's/Dementia Care Unit is now complete.

III. Methodology

On January 19, 2011, an application for licensure of 75 home for the aged beds was submitted.

On May 5, 2011, a letter from authorized representative/administrator Kathleen Quigley was submitted requesting to modify the application by reducing the number of beds from 75 to 60 beds total capacity and add the program for the Alzheimer's/Dementia Care Unit.

On June 25, 2012, the facility's description of services provided to residents with Alzheimer's disease or a related condition was approved.

On July 31, 2012, Riyadh Almuktar, Engineer with the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Health Systems Division of Health Facilities and Services, granted occupancy approval of the new Alzheimer's/Dementia Care Unit .


IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

See Original Licensing Study Report dated June 29, 2012, for the physical description of the Alzheimer's/Dementia Care Unit and its program for resident care.

The entire facility is now in full compliance with the applicable rules and statutes.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that Charlotte Stephenson Manor home for the aged license include the Alzheimer's/Dementia program and that the capacity be increased to 60 total home for the aged beds.
