II. Purpose of Addendum

During the renewal of license inspection of 4/16/2012, Ms. Seifert asked that her facility be designated as wheelchair accessible due to the installation of wheelchair ramps at both points of egress in the facility.

III. Methodology

11/09/2012 On-site inspection. Assessment and measurement of wheelchair ramps installed at main egress door.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 11/05/2012, Mrs. Elkins requested that this facility be designated as wheelchair accessible.

On 11/09/2012, I measured and inspected the wooden ramp constructed at the primary means of egress door. This ramp met all applicable licensing requirements, it terminates on a firm surface with handrails on the open sides and the slope of the ramps measured as not being more than one foot of rise in twelve feet of run, all in accordance with R 400.1439.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the terms of the license be modified to include wheelchair accessibility.
