II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee’s authorized representative has requested to increase the licensed bed capacity of the facility.

III. Methodology

On 11/18/2013, the licensee authorized representative submitted a written request to increase the licensed bed capacity. On 11/22/13, I reviewed the facility licensing file.


IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility was originally licensed for 72 licensed beds in 2000. In 2003, per the licensee’s request, the licensed bed capacity was lowered to 48 licensed beds to accommodate the market conditions of individuals desiring single occupancy rooms. Mr. Ebling states the market conditions now are reflecting the desire of individuals requesting semi-private rooms. Mr. Ebling states the facility has had no major modifications or alterations to the physical layout of the facility since its original licensure.


I reviewed the Health Facilities and Engineering Section room sheets and determined the facility exceeds the minimum physical plant requirements for 72 licensed beds with 2744 square feet of day and dining room space. The room sheets specify that the facility has four resident room floor plans consisting of 197, 198, 200, and 232 square feet of floor space. All resident room floor plans exceed the required 160 square foot minimum licensed bed requirement for double occupancy.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the facility licensed bed capacity be raised to reflect 72 licensed beds.
