The purpose of this addendum is to make this facility wheelchair accessible.

III. Methodology

05/15/2014 Contact – Document received

Received an e-mail from licensee requesting an inspection of the facility's new wheelchair ramps.

05/20/2014 Inspection Completed On-site

06/17/2014 Contact – Document received

Received a Request For Modification form from licensee regarding changing the facility's license status to make the facility wheelchair accessible.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 5/20/14, an on-site inspection was conducted to view the facility's newly installed wheelchair ramps. The facility installed a wheelchair ramp at the front entrance/exit that leads directly to the driveway. The facility also installed a second wheelchair ramp to the rear entrance/exit of the facility. The facility extended the wooden deck on the back of the facility to run the entire length of the side of the home, with the attached wheelchair ramp leading directly to the driveway at the front of the facility. Both wheelchair ramps were inspected and found to be in compliance with all applicable licensing rules.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that this facility's license be changed to reflect that it is now wheelchair accessible.
