II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of the addendum is to show that the licensed capacity of the home will be increased from 5 residents to a maximum of 6 residents. The facility will also utilize a fourth bedroom for resident use.

III. Methodology

December 9, 2014 – Request to increase capacity and to utilize a fourth bedroom for resident use was received from the Licensee.

December 9, 2014 – On-site inspection completed.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The facility will now have two double occupancy bedrooms and two single occupancy bedrooms. The dimensions are as follows:

Bedroom #1 – 10'2"X12'9" – 130 sq. ft. – 2 residents

Bedroom #2 - 10'6"X12'6" – 131 sq. ft. – 2 residents

Bedroom #3 – 9'3"X9'4" – 86 sq. ft. – 1 resident

Bedroom #4 – 9'4"X11'3" – 105 sq. ft. -1 resident

Total common living space is sufficient to accommodate all members of the household and residents.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the additional resident bedroom and increased resident capacity be approved as stated above.
