II. Purpose of Addendum

To increase capacity from 5 to 6 residents.

III. Methodology

On 12/29/2014, I received a letter from Ben Woiwode, the Licensee Designee for this home, requesting an increase in capacity from **5** to **6** residents.

On 12/29/2014, I reviewed the Original Licensing Report and noted that the bedroom dimensions and living space square footage.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

This home has four bedrooms, each with the same measurements ($12 \times 12.5 = 150$ square feet), which meet the requirement of a minimum of 65 square feet per resident. Any of these bedrooms could be used to have two residents in it to make the home's total capacity of **6**.

This home also has approximately 1112 square feet a living space, which surpasses the requirement of a minimum of 35 square feet of living space per resident.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the capacity of this home be increased from 5 to 6.
