II. Purpose of Addendum

On August 4, 2015, I conducted an on-site inspection and measured the room.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On August 4, 2015, the office measured 13'7" X 12'5" which is a total of 171'8" square feet. This is ample space for two residents.

The bedroom upstairs that is currently measured for three residents will now be licensed for two residents.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the room that is currently being used for an office be licensed as a bedroom for two (2) residents, and the upstairs bedroom licensed for three (3) residents now be licensed for two (2) residents.
