II. Purpose of Addendum

Licensee requested approval to use two bedrooms in lower level for resident use.

III. Methodology

On 11/30/15, I conducted an on-site inspection to review the lower level for resident use.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Licensee has obtained building inspections for electrical, plumbing and building from local inspectors and will keep these approvals on record. The two resident bedrooms were examined; the southern bedroom has 93 sq. ft. and the northern bedroom has 87 sq. ft. The licensee has dry walled the lower area and it is found to meet all requirements for resident use. Fire alarms in the lower area meet criteria.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the use of two resident bedrooms in the lower area. Licensee is aware that only ambulatory residents may occupy these bedrooms in the lower level.
