III. Methodology

On 10/27/2016, Mary Dotson provided me with a written request to increase the capacity from 5 to 6.

On 10/27/2016, I observed the bedroom that a sixth resident would share with another resident. The measurements of the room are 12’7” by 12’3” for a total of 154 square feet.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The bedroom proposed for adding a sixth resident meets the floor space requirement for two residents. It also has two beds, a dresser, chair, and mirror.

Also, the home has more than the required living space for six residents.

V. Recommendation

I recommend that the capacity of this home’s license be increased from 5 to 6 residents.
