IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 11/15/16 I received a written request from licensee designee Martin Molino requesting to add the Alzheimer's population to the license. I informed Mr. and Mrs. Molino to submit an updated program statement and admission policy which includes the Alzheimer's population and meets the requirements outlined in Section 400.726b (1) in the Act 218 of the Public Acts of 1979.

On 12/16/16 I reviewed all of the requested documentation and concluded that the administrator, Ms. Kalamejski, has the experience and training required to provide care in the home to the Alzheimer's population, and is in the process of training all direct care staff.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the license is modified to include the Alzheimer population.
