II. Purpose of Addendum

To re-evaluate the home's capacity to accept and retain persons who require the regular use of a wheelchair.

III. Methodology

On 10/18/16, I conducted an onsite inspection at the facility per the request of the licensee to inspect the newly installed wheelchair ramps.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Since the issuance of the original license, Mr. Swider installed wheelchair ramps at both required means of egress. Both ramps meet the licensing requirements. Specifically, the ramp off from the garage has 18 feet of rise and the rise is a foot and a half. The ramp closest to the deck has 2 feet of rise and 24.2 feet of run. Therefore, these specifications satisfy the Rules.

V. Recommendation

I recommend the license be modified to include wheelchair accessibility.
