II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum is to document an increase in licensed bed capacity as well as the development of a memory care unit. The facility has requested to increase their capacity to 64 by adding two one-bedroom apartments and four two-bedroom apartments in the general assisted living section of the facility. The facility has also developed a memory care program with 14 one-bedroom apartments.

III. Methodology

On 12/20/16, I completed an onsite inspection at the facility, specifically observing the facility's addition of six general assisted living apartments and the 14 apartments in the newly developed memory care unit.

On 12/22/16, Health Facilities and Engineering completed their opening survey report. The report stated the building was approved for resident occupancy. Bureau of Fire Services granted full fire safety approval on 12/16/16.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

White Lake Assisted Living is a single story building with six newly added general assisted living apartments comprised of four two-bedroom apartments and two one-bedroom apartments. Each apartment contains a kitchenette comprised of a small refrigerator and counter top sink. Each apartment is outfitted with a handicapped accessible shower, toilet and sink. Each resident wears a bracelet or pendent that activates an IPod carried by staff. Each apartment has its own heat and air conditioning controls as well as a washer and dryer.

The newly constructed secure memory care unit has 14 single occupancy apartments. The memory care unit is comprised of two corridors, Hickory Knoll and Lincoln club, with seven apartments in each. Connecting both corridors at the north side is a common day/dining area with a kitchenette. The apartments are outfitted with a handicapped accessible toilet and sink. There is a shower room in each corridor and one spa room with a therapeutic whirlpool.

Each resident in the memory care unit will be outfitted with a bracelet or pendent that when activated by the resident will alert staff that assistance is needed. The layout within the secured unit provides an area for residents to relax, socialize and participate in activities in a safe, home like atmosphere. All of the front and side entrances to the building are secured with a delayed egress magnetic locking systems. If an individual exits the community without entering a code an alarm will sound notifying staff which door has been breached without proper code entry.

I reviewed the home's proposed memory care unit program statement. It is compliant with the requirements of MCL.333.20178.

V. Recommendation


I recommend the capacity be increased to 64 and the facility's memory care program be approved.
