II. Purpose of Addendum

To make the home wheelchair accessible.

III. Methodology

On 7/25/18, I conducted an onsite inspection at the facility to measure the wheelchair ramps at the front and rear of house.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The licensee added 2 wheelchair ramps placing one at the front entrance and the other at the rear entrance of the home. Both ramps meet the licensing requirements with respect to their rise and run measurements. In addition, the licensee remodeled the bathroom by installing a walk-in shower stall that can accommodate wheelchairs.

V. Recommendation

The home is approved to accept residents who require the regular use of a wheelchair.
