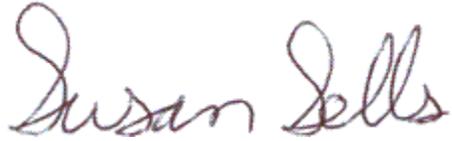

ALLEGATION:

On the morning of 6/22/19, there was a fire at this facility. All the residents were evacuated safely. The cause of the fire is unknown at this time.

INVESTIGATION:

On 6/22/19, I spoke to the facility’s attorney, Amir Abuaita, via telephone. He stated that earlier this morning, the facility caught on fire. He said that the two staff working were able to successfully evacuate all the residents. Nobody was injured and nobody required medical attention.

According to Mr. Abuaita, all the residents were transported to the Clio Senior Center. All of the residents’ family members have been contacted. Community members donated food and drinks. The local pharmacy delivered the resident’s medications and Mr. Abuaita is working on finding placements for all the residents.

On 6/22/19, I completed a Critical Incident Report and sent it to management.

I received an Incident/Accident Report dated 6/22/19 at 9:10am. According to the report, there was a fire at the facility which effected the entire home. All 12 residents were evacuated.

On 6/24/19, I spoke to Mr. Abuaita about the status of the residents. He said that he was able to find placement for all the residents. He provided me with the names of all the residents and the names of the facilities in which they now reside. He told me that according to the fire chief, it is believed that the fire started in the garage of the facility.

On 6/25/19, I sent an email and the completed Critical Incident Report to Mark Hornberger from the Bureau of Fire Services.

On 7/08/19, I received an email from Mr. Hornberger. According to him, per the Fire Chief, Michigan State Police have ruled the fire “undetermined.” He said that whenever there are two or more possible causes of a fire, it is ruled undetermined. He stated that the area of the garage where the fire started was where residents and staff smoked so it was either that or something to do with the electrical in that area.

On 7/10/19, I conducted an onsite visual inspection of A&M Adult Foster Care facility. I noted that the facility has extensive fire damage and is obviously uninhabitable. I took photographs of the outside of the facility but was not able to enter the facility.

On 7/12/19, I spoke to the licensee designee, Mounirah Abuaita via telephone. She confirmed that all the residents have been placed in other facilities and that the fire was ruled undetermined. She stated that she has been in contact with the insurance company and is exploring her options regarding rebuilding this facility. Ms. Abuaita said that staff and residents did not smoke in the garage and she was told that the fire was most likely caused by an electrical problem.

On 7/12/19, I interviewed staff Amanda Horton, via telephone. Ms. Horton confirmed that on 6/22/19, she and staff Rachel Brown were working 1st shift at A&M AFC. Ms. Horton said that all the residents had finished breakfast, and most were either resting in their rooms or in the common areas of the facility. She said that she walked by Resident A who said "Amanda, there's smoke." She stated that she looked toward the garage door and saw "tons of black smoke coming from the garage." According to Ms. Horton, she yelled for Ms. Brown and they both began evacuating all the residents. She said that she contacted 911 and Ms. Abuaita. Ms. Horton confirmed that she and Ms. Brown were able to safely evacuate all residents, and no one was injured. She said that she has no idea what could have caused the fire.

Ms. Horton said that neither she nor Ms. Brown smokes cigarettes. She said that Residents I and J do smoke cigarettes but none of the staff or residents smoke in the garage. There is a designated smoking area outside of the facility by the garage. She stated that whenever Residents I or J goes outside to smoke, staff always accompanies them. However, she said that neither Resident I nor J had been outside to smoke that morning prior to the fire.

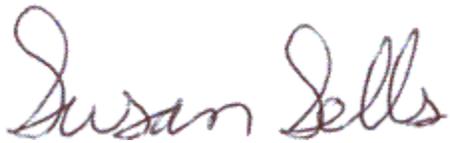
On 7/12/19, I conducted an exit conference with Ms. Abuaita via telephone. I discussed the results of my investigation and explained which rule violation I am substantiating. Ms. Abuaita agreed to complete and submit a corrective action plan upon the receipt of my investigation report. She said that she will let me know once she decides what she is going to do about the status of her license but said that as of now, she wants her license to remain active.

APPLICABLE RULE	
R 400.14403	Maintenance of premises.
	(1) A home shall be constructed, arranged, and maintained to provide adequately for the health, safety, and well-being of occupants.

ANALYSIS:	<p>On 6/22/19, there was a fire at this facility. All residents were evacuated safely, and new placements were found for all of them. The facility is uninhabitable, and the licensee is deciding whether to rebuild the facility.</p> <p>I conclude that there is sufficient evidence to substantiate this rule violation since the facility is no longer habitable for residents.</p>
CONCLUSION:	VIOLATION ESTABLISHED

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon the receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend no change in the license status.
