III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 400.14311	Investigation and reporting of incidents, accidents, illnesses, absences, and death.
	<p>(1) A licensee shall make a reasonable attempt to contact the resident's designated representative and responsible agency by telephone and shall follow the attempt with a written report to the resident's designated representative, responsible agency, and the adult foster care licensing division within 48 hours of any of the following:</p> <p>(c) Incidents that involve any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Displays of serious hostility. (ii) Hospitalization. (iii) Attempts at self-inflicted harm or harm to others. (iv) Instances of destruction to property.

During the on-site inspection on 06/03/19, Resident A was hospitalized on 12/17/18 for a clogged peg tube, but there was not an incident report completed or submitted to me within 48 hours of Resident A's hospitalization.

R 400.14312	Resident medications.
	<p>(4) When a licensee, administrator, or direct care staff member supervises the taking of medication by a resident, he or she shall comply with all of the following provisions:</p> <p>(c) Record the reason for each administration of medication that is prescribed on an as needed basis.</p>

During the on-site inspection on 06/03/19, I reviewed Resident A and Resident C's medications and medication logs. I found the following medication errors:

- Resident A's **Ondansetron 4MG TAB**: take one tab via tube every eight hours as needed for nausea/vomiting was given on 05/27/19 at 3:00AM, but the reason for this as needed medication was not documented.
- Resident C's **Triamcinolon 0.1% OIN**: apply and gently massage into affected area(s) twice daily was applied on 04/10/19 at 4:00PM, 04/17/19 at 7PM and 04/20/19 at 3:00PM, but the reasons for this as needed ointment was not documented.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
