II. Purpose of Addendum

The licensee requested to increase the memory care licensed beds to 21.

III. Methodology

On 8/17/18, Health Facilities Engineering Section Pier-George Zanoni provided partial occupancy approval for the renovated memory care area of this facility. The licensed bed capacity was limited to 15 beds until the time the facility developed bathing facilities to support the full complement of 21 licensed beds. On 12/4/18, Mr. Zanoni granted full occupancy approval resulting in an overall facility licensed bed capacity of 83. On 12/6/18, I completed an onsite inspection.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The bathing room is handicap accessible and includes a large walk-in shower, toilet, sink and has ample cabinet space for storage. The bathroom is outfitted with emergency pull cords located next to the toilet and in the shower to alert staff if assistance is needed.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that the licensed bed capacity increase to 83.
