II. Purpose of Addendum

The facility requested a decrease in licensed capacity from 72 beds to 56 beds based on a trend of declining admissions and interest in sharing double occupancy rooms.

III. Methodology

On 6/28/19, an email was received from authorized representative Diane Vondette requesting an occupancy decrease from 72 to 56 beds. Operational details were included with the request. Per Ms. Vondette, no structural changes will occur, just having room designations changed. On 7/23/19, an email was received from Ms. Vondette with a floor plan relative to the occupancy decrease request.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The room conversion includes the discontinued use of rooms 105 through 111. Additionally, rooms 204, 205 and 206 as well as rooms 404, 406, 407, 408, 409 and 410 will be reduced from a two-bed capacity to a one bed capacity.

V. Recommendation


It is recommended that the capacity of Chesaning Comfort Care be decreased to 56.
