II. Purpose of Addendum

The facility requested a decrease in licensed capacity from 76 beds to 65 beds based on resident lack of interest in sharing double occupancy rooms.

III. Methodology

On 11/5/19, an email was received from authorized representative Diane Vondette requesting an occupancy decrease from 76 to 65 beds. Operational details and a floor plan were included with the request. Per Ms. Vondette, no structural changes will occur, just having room designations changed.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The licensees reasoning for the lowering of capacity from two to one licensed bed within rooms 103, 104, 106, 107, 108, 110, 113, 114, 210, 304 and 305 poses no conflicts with statute or rule.

V. Recommendation


It is recommended that the bed capacity of Bavarian Comfort Care be decreased from 76 to 65 beds.
