## II. Purpose of Addendum

The purpose of this addendum report is to correct the capacity noted on the original licensing study from five to three residents.

## III. Methodology

02/18/2020 I received a call from a concerned citizen.
02/18/2020 I reviewed the original licensing study report on LARA website.
02/18/2020 I emailed licensee designees Tive Ewaraye, Laura Ewaraye and administrator Anneth Ewaraye.

02/18/2020 I received a phone call from Anneth Ewaraye and discussed the capacity error

02/21/2020 I received two discharge notices from Anneth Ewaraye.

## IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 02/18/2020, I received a call from a concerned citizen who inquired about the capacity of the home. The person said that original licensing study report on the Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) website capacity for the home is five however, in the body of the report the capacity for the home is three.

On 02/18/2020, I reviewed the original licensing study report on LARA website. I observed that the capacity was listed as five. However, there were only three bedrooms measured.

Resident bedrooms were measured during the on-site inspection on 06/04/2018 and have the following dimensions:

| Bedroom \# | Room Dimensions | Total Square Footage | Total Resident Beds |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| 1 | $10 \times 10$ | 100 | 1 |
| 2 | $9 \times 9$ | 81 | 1 |
| 3 | $11 \times 10$ | 110 | 1 |

Based on the above information, it is concluded that this facility can accommodate three (3) residents. It is the licensee's responsibility not to exceed the facility's licensed capacity.

On 02/18/2020, I emailed licensee designees Tive Ewaraye, Laura Ewaraye and administrator Anneth Ewaraye. I informed them that the correct total capacity is three and if there are more than three residents, 30-day discharge notices should
be issued. I requested that copies of the notices be faxed to licensing for verification.

On 02/18/2020, I received a phone call from Anneth Ewaraye and discussed the capacity error and that an addendum to the original licensing study report will be issued. Anneth Ewaraye confirmed that there were five residents living in the home and agreed to issue 30-day discharge notices effective 02/19/2020.

I observed that the capacity of the home was incorrect on the original licensing study report. I corrected the capacity from five to three residents.

## V. Recommendation

It is recommended that the license capacity is corrected from five to three residents.
