### **ALLEGATION:**

**Resident A had three hospitalizations due to behaviors.**

### **INVESTIGATION:**

The Home for the Aged licensing staff Andrea Krausmann received three incident reports regarding Resident A's behaviors, all requiring hospitalization. In the incident reports, staff described Resident A's behaviors as aggressive (hitting and yelling) towards herself, staff, and other residents, as well as destructive to facility property. The corrective measures for the three incidents were to consult SPS (Senior Psychiatry Services) for increased agitation and medication evaluations.

I reviewed Resident A's progress notes. On 10/29/20 at 12:30 PM, Resident A arrived at the facility "showing signs of violence and psychosis" according to the facility DNP (Doctor of Nursing Practice). On 10/30/20 at 5:00 am, Resident A had increased agitation, refusing care, swing and pushing staff. On 11/17/20, Resident A was seen by SPS, who added Ativan 0.5 mg oral daily to her medications. On 11/29/20, the progress note references the incident report for that date. On 11/30/20, Resident A was seen by SPS, who changed her medication regimen. On 12/1/20, the progress note references the incident report for that date and facility staff wrote, "Resident is a danger to herself and needs assistance outside of what we can provide at this time."

I reviewed Resident A's service plan. The service plan stated, "expresses agitation by tones -yelling-swinging at staff" and to see the attached behavior sheet to the service plan. The attached behavior sheet was dated 10/26/20 and dated again on 11/17, with an initial behind it. The behavior sheet provided general interventions for agitation. The behavior sheet was not specific to Resident A nor did it provide any other specific non-pharmacologic interventions for the behaviors on 11/29, 12/1 and 12/11.

	<b>(21) "Service plan" means a written statement prepared by the home in cooperation with a resident and/or the resident's authorized representative or agency responsible for a resident's placement, if any, and that identifies the specific care and maintenance, services, and resident activities appropriate for each individual resident's physical, social, and behavioral needs and well-being and the methods of providing the care and services while taking into account the preferences and competency of the resident.</b>

<b>ANALYSIS:</b>	Review of Resident A's service plan, incident reports and progress notes revealed Resident A had behaviors requiring a change in her care needs. Resident A's service plan was not updated to reflect her specific care needs.
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	<b>VIOLATION ESTABLISHED</b>

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

Contingent upon an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend the status of the license remain unchanged.




