II. Purpose of Addendum

A request was made by the administrator/authorized representative Mark Kincer to decrease the facility's licensed bed capacity to 62.

III. Methodology

On 12/30/20, an email was received from Mr. Kincer outlining the number of beds to decrease with an attachment of bed changes and a BCAL 1600 application.

On 1/4/21, I requested Mr. Kincer to list the room numbers that he is requesting to decrease beds within.

On 1/5/21, a revised letter was received detailing the room numbers and beds to be decreased.

I updated the licensing file facility room sheets with the new licensed capacity of the revised rooms.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

Mr. Kincer explained that the reduction in beds is a result of having single occupancy in all but four of the two-bedrooms floor plan styles (Rooms #14, 38, 39, and 49). All the other rooms will remain single occupancy.

V. Recommendation

It is recommended that the licensed bed capacity decrease to 62.
