The facility has requested to reduce the licensed bed capacity from 331 to 301.

III. Methodology

On 5/12/21, licensing was notified by the facility authorized representative Craig Courts that de-licensing 30 beds was requested effective 5/14. The Willow neighborhood of the facility has relocated its residents to another area within the home for the aged and will no longer utilize the 30 licensed beds.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

On 5/13/21, I reviewed the room sheets for the facility. I find no conflicts with the identified licensed bed reduction.

V. Recommendation


I recommend the license capacity to be lowered to 301 beds.
