II. Purpose of Addendum

On 12/05/2003, the licensee submitted a written request to modify the terms of their license, i.e., increase capacity from four to six residents. This addendum is completed to documents the findings of the on-site inspection in response to the licensee's modification request.

III. Methodology

On 12/11/2003, an on-site inspection was completed to evaluate the facility's compliance with all applicable licensing rules, pertaining to environmental health, fire safety, and physical plant.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The proposed resident bedrooms were measured and the dimensions are as follows:

Bedroom # 1 contains 168 square feet of usable floor space and will accommodate two (2) residents.

Bedroom # 4 contains 221 square feet of usable floor space and will accommodate two (2) residents.

Bedroom # 2 and # 3 will remain as single occupancy resident bedrooms.

The family room contains 240 square feet of indoor living space and this is adequate for six (6) occupants.

The maximum total capacity is approved for six (6) residents.

The licensee submitted documentation to certify that the prospective residents are utilizing their own personal bedroom furniture and therefore, said furniture will accompany the residents upon their move-in. Currently, the bedrooms have furniture being utilized by the existing residents.

V. Recommendation

Based on the above findings, it is recommended that the capacity for this facility be increased from four (4) to six (6) residents.
