III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This facility was found to be in non-compliance with the following rules:

R 330.1803 Facility environment; fire safety.

(3) A facility that has a capacity of 4 or more clients shall conduct and document fire drills at least once during daytime, evening, and sleeping hours during every 3-month period.

Fire drills were not completed as required. Fire drills were missing for September 2020, November 2019, and December 2019.

R 400.14203 Licensee and administrator training requirements.

- (1) A licensee and an administrator shall complete the following educational requirements specified in subdivision (a) or (b) of this subrule, or a combination thereof, on an annual basis:
- (a) Participate in, and successfully complete, 16 hours of training designated or approved by the department that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement.
- (b) Have completed 6 credit hours at an accredited college or university in an area that is relevant to the licensee's admission policy and program statement as approved by the department.

The licensee designee failed to show verification of completion of the required annual training hours.

R 400.14210 Resident register.

A licensee shall maintain a chronological register of residents who are admitted to the home. The register shall include all of the following information for each resident:

- (a) Date of admission.
- (b) Date of discharge.
- (c) Place and address to which the resident moved, if known.

The resident register was not available for review. It could not be located.

R 400.14301

Resident admission criteria; resident assessment plan; emergency admission; resident care agreement; physician's instructions; health care appraisal.

(6) At the time of a resident's admission, a licensee shall complete a written resident care agreement. A resident care agreement is the document which is established between the resident or the resident's designated representative, the responsible agency, if applicable, and the licensee and which specifies the responsibilities of each party.

Resident A's resident care agreement did not have any of the required signatures.

R 400.14316 Resident records.

- (1) A licensee shall complete, and maintain in the home, a separate record for each resident and shall provide record information as required by the department. A resident record shall include, at a minimum, all of the following information:
- (a) Identifying information, including, at a minimum, all of the following:
 - (i) Name.
- (ii) Social security number, date of birth, case number, and marital status.
 - (iii) Former address.
- (iv) Name, address, and telephone number of the next of kin or the designated representative.
- (v) Name, address, and telephone number of the person and agency responsible for the resident's placement in the home.
- (vi) Name, address, and telephone number of the preferred physician and hospital.
 - (vii) Medical insurance.
 - (viii) Funeral provisions and preferences.
 - (ix) Resident's religious preference information.
 - (b) Date of admission.
- (c) Date of discharge and the place to which the resident was discharged.
- (d) Health care information, including all of the following:
 - (i) Health care appraisals.
 - (ii) Medication logs.

- (iii) Statements and instructions for supervising prescribed medication, including dietary supplements and individual special medical procedures.
 - (iv) A record of physician contacts.
- (v) Instructions for emergency care and advanced medical directives.
 - (e) Resident care agreement.
 - (f) Assessment plan.
 - (g) Weight record.
 - (h) Incident reports and accident records.
- (i) Resident funds and valuables record and resident refund agreement.
 - (j) Resident grievances and complaints.

Resident A's file did not have an identification record in it as required.

R 400.14403 Maintenance of premises.

(1) A home shall be constructed, arranged, and maintained to provide adequately for the health, safety, and well-being of occupants.

The fire extinguishers were due for servicing. They were last serviced July 2020.

The furnace inspection was overdue. It was last inspected 05/27/2020.

The bathroom exhaust knob was missing and the exhaust could not turn on.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Contingent upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, renewal of the license is recommended.
